Ministers' Reports:

Bridget gave thanks for a great annual meeting and for those who came to the Black History Month exhibit. There may be a June 1 bus trip to Gospel Fest at Millennium Park in Chicago, continuing our collaborations with Divine Temple Church of God in Christ. This is the 20th anniversary year of Union becoming ONA. We need to plan how to celebrate. Bridget distributed her schedule through September. The next congregational quarterly meeting will be April 28.

Jon reported that a Jazz ministry team has been formed including representatives from the Worship and Outreach Ministries as well as some outside folks. Others will be invited to participate. We are still waiting for the response to the Calvin Seminary Worshiping in New Ways grant proposal. He is currently working on 3 initiatives: (1) Bringing Partners for Sacred Places to Green Bay, which helps sacred buildings maximize their physical assets; (2) a Greater

Green Bay Community Foundation planning grant for the Brain Center of Green Bay around the intersection of spirituality and health; and (3) a pared-down Lilly Foundation grant to administer the program of interns from secular disciplines to support the churches' operations. He would like to hear other ideas from members of the Congregation. Wednesdays during Lent will feature Dinner Church, which will include a dinner with some guided questions, recorded music and prayer during the normal dinner time before PF/YCA and Seminary Secrets.

Clerk's Report

Whereas, Section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code permits a minister of the gospel to exclude from gross income (in computing federal income taxes) a church-designated allowance paid to him as part of his compensation to the extent used by him for actual expenses in owning or renting a home; and

Whereas, the Rev. Bridget Flad Daniels is compensated by Union Congregational United Church of Christ exclusively for the services as a minister of the gospel; and Whereas, Union Congregational United Church of Christ does not provide the Rev. Bridget Flad Daniels with a parsonage, therefore, it is hereby resolved that: the total compensation for housing and salary paid to the Rev. Bridget Flad Daniels for calendar year 2019 shall be \$75,013 of which \$32,256 (43%) is hereby designated to be a housing allowance, and

the designation of \$32,256 as a housing allowance shall apply to calendar year 2019 and all future years unless otherwise provided.
